## Latrobe Youth Space secures a partial funding outcome from Victoria's Allan Labour Government!

Celebrating today, the Board of local *for-purpose* organisation *Gippsland Youth Spaces Inc. (GYS Inc)* was happy to be the recipient of a state government grant of \$250,000 that will enable the Latrobe Valley based space to operate for a further six months.

The GYS Board has plans to establish multiple lines of funding for our projects. We will work with industry and business; local government and with State and Federal Governments to ensure ongoing funding.

The Morwell based facility is part of a range of youth facilities and services delivered by GYS Inc. Its overarching principle is that the services delivered are those that young people have determined are needed – by young people.

## **Enabling Youth Voice:**

GYS's motto is as simple as Youth led, adult guided: nothing about us, without us.

To this end, the Board of GYS is an equal partnership of young people – under the age of 25 and others, including other for-purpose entities such as the Centre for Multicultural Youth, Baw Baw Latrobe LLEN and GippSport.

Young People – or at least, those over 15 years – are members of the GYS Inc legal entity. They attend annual general meetings and vote for the election of board members.

A group of 35 young people comprise the Youth Programs Committee that decides which activities/projects will be funded by GYS.

Later this month a delegation of young people is travelling to Canberra to meet with decision makers to ensure the voice of young people is being heard. The Hon. Darren Chester – local Federal member is facilitating the trip.

In December, the Board announced several sponsorship opportunities for local small businesses to be a part of the GYS story. The first business to take up the offer was Full Circle HR, which has committed to a regular monthly sponsorship amount. GYS wishes to publicly thank Full Circle, and its Managing Director Caitlin Grigsby for her support and advice.
